SUMMARY: The Carpenters on our team have an understanding of conventional framing and general carpentry. They may be a Timber Frame Apprentice, or have some knowledge of timber frame construction, as well as an understanding of how building envelopes work and basic building science. They love doing good work and learning—and like to have variety in their work— with an interest in restoration and new construction.

The carpenter is caring and team oriented; a critical thinker, problem-solver - that has the ability to follow specific instructions from a Site Lead and communicate clearly about methodology and changes in plan. They possess manual dexterity, a firm grasp of safety and basic tool use, as well as other basic carpentry skills. They hold an OSHA 10 card, and Class B CDL, and bring a basic set of tools and PPE with them to site.
